Chandler R. Finley, Esq. A U.S. citizen born in Miami Beach, Florida, and also an Italian citizen, Mr. Finley has been member of the Florida Bar practicing law in the fields of immigration, international, corporate, real estate, and entertainment law since 1988. In 2005, he was awarded Board Certification as a specialist in International Law by the Florida Bar. He received his Juris Doctor law degree from Emory University School of Law and his Bachelor's of Arts Degree in Political Science and Music Performance in 1985 from Emory University in Atlanta, Georgia.

Mr. Finley focuses his legal practice on immigration matters, including visas for investors, business, entertainers, institutions, professionals, family and asylum; international business assisting foreign entities establish US offices and business; corporate, and entertainment representing the music, art and film industries. Mr. Finley also served as Legal Counsel for 15 years to the county administrative entity managing federal and state funding for Palm Beach County's regional workforce board known as the Workforce Alliance, Palm Beach County Workforce Development Board, and earlier as the Palm Beach County Private Industry Council, and currently serves as Legal Counsel to the International Studies Charter High School in Miami.

Mr. Finley also handles commercial and residential real estate transactions, representing buyers, sellers and developers, throughout the tri-county area, Miami-Dade, Broward and Palm Beach County, for over 18 years. Since 2005 Mr. Finley has been a Member & Title Agent of Attorney's Title Insurance Fund (The Fund). From 1991 – 1994 he was an active Title Agent for Chicago Title Insurance Company and for American Title Insurance Company and an associated closing attorney for Citibank, Great Southern Bank, Fidelity Federal, Citibank Mortgage and Mortgage Re-Finance Division, Associates National Bank's National Relocation Mortgages Department, Relocations, handling all title matters and real estate legal matters, averaging five closings per week. Mr. Finley comes from a family background of real estate developers in Florida and nationwide, and residential and commercial real estate brokers.

Mr. Finley has been a member of the Florida Bar Association, the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Florida, Federal Bar Association, American Bar Association, International Bar Association, International Law Section of the Florida Bar Association, Sports and Entertainment Law Section of the Florida Bar Association, American Immigration Lawyers Association, Palm Beach County Bar Association Immigration Law Committee, National Italian American Bar Association, Italy-America Chamber of Commerce, World Trade Council of Palm Beach, and Palm Beach County Cultural Arts Council Volunteer Lawyer in the Arts. He has served as Legal Counsel for the Florida Motion Picture Television Association, Palm Beach County Florida Motion Picture Television Association, Guild for International Piano Competitions, Baroque Strings Orchestra, and has served as Board Member of the Florida Philharmonic Board of Directors.

Mr. Finley has been a lecturer in Immigration at Palm Beach County Bar Association seminars, Lynn University, Palm Beach State College, and for the Italy America Chamber of Commerce, in Entertainment Law at a Florida Bar Association seminar, and guest speaker on International Law and Federal Administrative Law at Palm Beach State College and Florida Atlantic University, and has authored several articles on Entertainment Law for the Florida Motion Picture Television Association, Palm Beach Chapter.

He founded the International Polo & Equestrian Sports Agency (IPESA) representing over 100 of the world's leading polo and Olympic equestrian sports athletes, and is a member of the U.S. Polo Association and has been a member of the Palm Beach County Sports Commission. Mr. Finley is also the founder of Finley Music and Entertainment representing artists, musicians and the film industry. Mr. Finley recently served for 5 years on the Board of Directors of the Italy America Chamber of Commerce, in Miami, and plays the violin as the Associate Concertmaster (1st Violin) of the Alhambra Orchestra in Miami.

In 1987 he studied International and European Law at Detroit College of Law, London Law Program at Regents College in London, England, and at the European Law Institute of the Free University in Brussels, Belgium, and at the Institute for European Studies in Vienna, Austria in 1984 which was in cooperation with an international law internship at The United Nations Complex, UN City, Vienna, Austria. Mr. Finley began his practical legal training in 1987 in London, England, U.K., and in Brussels, Belgium, working with two international law firms in Europe which concentrate in international and European law and commercial trade arbitration at the International Chamber of Commerce (ICC), after which he began his international practice in Palm Beach County. He also worked in Berlin, Germany in 1985 for the International Institute for Comparative Social Research as the assistant to Dr. Karl Deutsch, the world renowned political scientist and director of the world political and government computer models. In the U.S., Mr. Finley was an Aide to President Jimmy Carter in 1985 and assisted with international law conferences sponsored by President Jimmy Carter after his presidency at the Carter Center of Emory University in Atlanta, Georgia, and in 1984 Mr. Finley was a Legislative Aide to a Georgia State Legislator. Mr. Finley is a member of Chi Phi (ΧΦ) Fraternity, Gamma.
